

Reviewing Results V.2

1. Once **all testing** has been completed on a sample, you'll receive an email from our lab informing you of the results.
2. To track your testing progress and/or view results before sample completion, click on Results from the navigational menu option.



3. Your Results screen will look like the image below and will include all samples the lab has received. If the lab has not received your samples you will find them in the Submitted Samples tab.

4. If you submit samples for more than one species, you'll want to select the appropriate Lab from the drop-down box.
5. Results can be filtered by Test Type, Result and Operator/Value drop downs.
6. All the results data can be filtered by clicking the three dots to the right of each column heading. As a reference, circled in red is the filter feature for Sample Number and Status.
7. Only 20 samples appear per page, but you can increase the content number by clicking the arrow.
8. If you're having trouble finding results, it could be that the proper Testing Season isn't selected. This selection option can be found in the image below. The default is Current Year, so you may need to adjust your search accordingly.

9. Once you're ready to view the Report of Analysis for the specific samples, generate the report by selecting one of the five options listed in the image below.

- a. Condensed Report: A shorter version of the landscape, only showing NORM, Trait %, Positives
- b. Landscape: Full report showing NORM, ABN, Deads, Trait %, Positives
- c. Portrait: Used for all species other than corn and soybeans. Also used for Non Standard results for all species.
- d. Excel: Results are laid out in an Excel format, easy for sorting data. *Does not show Non Standard results.
- e. Export All: This is a data pull of all samples received, in the year selected, in an Excel file format. The data pull runs in the background, sending a notification when the file is available.
